## What will you be studying?

The Bachelor of Arts program in Economics degree is designed to offer students maximum flexibility in designing a program of study.

The Bachelor of Science program in Economics differs from the Bachelor of Arts degree, in that it requires more quantitative and data analysis courses, but does not require a foreign language. Students have flexibility in the choice of their electives, or can choose an option in one of the following areas:

### Money and financial markets

You will develop institutional knowledge and analytical skills to explore the complex and interdependent nature of money and financial markets.

### Global trade and finance

You will study the global trade and financial systems and their importance for understanding the role of institutions that support the global economy.

### Public policy and sustainability

You will examine the factors that influence economic, social, and environmental outcomes, and develop the institutional knowledge and theoretical perspective to understand the impact that decisions of individuals, firms, communities, and governments have on such outcomes.
